ORDINANCE NO. 19-0-02

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE CITY OF GROESBECK, TEXAS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR OCTOBER 1, 2019 TO SEPTEMBER 30, 2020

WHEREAS, Public Notice of a public hearing upon this budget has been duly and legally made as required by law; and

WHEREAS, FURTHER, after a full and final consideration, the public hearing has been held upon said budget and it is the consensus of opinion that the budget as filed should be approved. The financial condition and comparative expenditures as filed were duly considered.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that the City Council of the City of Groesbeck, Texas, ratify, report, adopt and approve the budget for Fiscal Year October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2020.

15. Consider Approval of Ordinance No. 19-O-03,l Adoption of City Tax Rate for 2019

Mayor O'Docharty presented Ordinance No. 19-O-03, Adoption of City Tax Rate for 2019 to the council for approval.

ORDINANCE NO. 19-0-03

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GROESBECK, TEXAS LEVYING AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE USE AND SUPPORT OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF THE CITY OF GROESBECK, TEXAS, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2019 AND TERMINATING SEPTEMBER 30, 2020; PROVIDING FOR APPORTIONING EACH LEVY FOR SPECIFIC PURPOSES, AND PROVIDING WHEN TAXES SHALL BECOME DUE AND WHEN SAME SHALL BECOME DELINQUENT IF NOT PAID.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Groesbeck, Texas approved the municipal budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2019 and ending September 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that an ordinance be passed levying an ad valorem tax on all property, both real and personal, within the corporate limits of the City of Groesbeck, Texas in accordance with such budget and the Texas Tax Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROESBECK, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That there is levied and shall be collected for the use and support of the municipal government of the City of Groesbeck, Texas, for the Fiscal Year 2019-2020, Tax Year 2019, upon all property, real, personal and mixed, within the corporate limits of said City subject to taxation, a tax of \$0.7189 on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) valuation of property, said tax being so levied and apportioned to the specific purposes herein set forth.

- (1) For the maintenance and support of the General Government (General Fund), (\$0.6830) on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) valuation of property.
- (2) For the debt service bonded indebtedness (\$0.0359) on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) valuation of property.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> (A) THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE.

SECTION 3. There is hereby levied and there shall be collected from every person, firm, association or corporation pursuing an occupation which is taxed by the General Laws of the State of Texas, annual occupation tax equal in each instance to one-half (½) of the State Occupation Tax, which said taxes shall be paid annually in advance except where otherwise provided by the State Laws, in which event, the same may be paid as is provided by the State Law.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> All receipts for the City of Groesbeck not specifically apportioned by this Ordinance are hereby made payable to the General Fund of the City of Groesbeck unless specifically authorized for other operational purposes.

SECTION 5. All monies collected under this Ordinance for specific items therein named be and the same are hereby appropriated and set apart for the specific purpose indicated in each item and that the City Secretary shall keep these accounts so as to readily and distinctly show the amounts collected, the amounts expended and the amounts on hand at any time belonging to such funds. It is hereby made the duty of every person collecting money for the City of Groesbeck, Texas to deliver to the City Secretary at the time of depositing any monies, a statement showing to what fund such deposit should be made and from what source received.

SECTION 6. That taxes levied under this ordinance shall be due October 1, 2019 and if not paid on or before January, 2020 shall immediately become delinquent, by the following motion, "I move for the adoption of a tax rate of "\$0.7189/\$100" which is effectively a"0" percent increase in the tax rate.
