AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AN AMENDED CITY OF GROESBECK INVESTMENT POLICY.

WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of Texas enacted House Bill 2459 amending the Public Funds Investment Act; and

WHEREAS, the Public Funds Investment Act, as amended, requires the city to adopt an investment policy by rule, order, ordinance or resolution; and

WHEREAS, the attached investment policy complies with the Public Funds Investment Act, as amended, and authorizes the investment of City funds in safe and prudent investments; and

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WHEREAS, the Public Funds Investment Act, as amended, requires the City to designate by rule, order, ordinance or resolution, one or more officers or employees of the City as investment officers to be responsible for the investment of its funds:

WHEREAS, the City is required to review the City's investment policy annually; and

WHEREAS, this review is authorized by the Public Funds Investment Act, as amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Groesbeck, Texas:

That the City of Groesbeck Investment Policy, as amended, attached hereto as "Exhibit A" is hereby adopted as the investment policy of the City of Groesbeck effective December, 2023.

WHEREAS, the City of Groesbeck is considering the submission of FEMA Hazard Mitigation Assistance grant application; and

WHEREAS, FEMA Mitigation Fund applicants are required to appoint an official to act as the Authorized Representative in all matters in connection with the Mitigation Grant; and

WHEREAS, FEMA Mitigation Fund applicants are required to commit 10% local matching funds to secure and complete the FEMA Mitigation Grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

- Section 1. That City of Groesbeck is authorizing the submission of an application for FEMA's Hazard Mitigation Assistance Grant Program; and
- Section 2. That the Mayor Matthew D. Dawley will be appointed the Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act on behalf of the City in all matters in connection with the FEMA Mitigation Grant; and
- Section 3. The City is committing to provide local matching funds contribution no greater than 25% to FEMA Mitigation Projects.

The Issuer desires to designate this Finance Contract as a "qualified tax-exempt obligation" of the Issuer for the purposes of Section 265 (b) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF GROESBECK: That the Issuer enters into a Finance Contract with Government Capital Corporation for the purpose Section 1. of financing a "Sewer Jet Truck". That the Finance Contract by and between the City of Groesbeck and Government Capital Section 2. Corporation is designated by the Issuer as a "qualified tax-exempt obligation" for the purposes of Section 265 (b) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. That the City of Groesbeck will designate the City Administrator, or designee, as an authorized Section 3. signer of the Finance Contract by and between the City of Groesbeck and Government Capital Corporation as well as any other ancillary exhibit, certificate, or documentation needed for the Contract. The Issuer will use loan proceeds for reimbursement of expenditures related to the Property, within the meaning of Treasury Regulation § 1.150-2, as promulgated under the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.
