

MINUTES FOR THE 18th DAY OF FEBRUARY, 2025

BE IT REMEMBERED THAT on Tuesday, February 18, 2025 the Groesbeck City Council met in Regular Session at 6:00 p.m. at the Groesbeck Council Chambers with the Honorable Mayor Pro tem Warren Anglin presiding and with Tamikia Jackson, Kim Harris, Pamela Gonner, Marcus McGruder, being present and with Mayor Matthew D.
