AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GROESBECK, TEXAS, ADOPTING YEAR 2024 AMENDMENT TO: WATER CONSERVATION AND

MINUTES FOR THE 17th DAY OF JUNE, 2025 CON'T

EMERGENCY WATER DEMAND MANAGEMENT PLAN APOPTED VIA ORDINANCE NO. 20-0-02 ON THE 17th DAY OF JUNE 2025

- WHEREAS, it is necessary that the Water Conservation and Emergency Water Demand Management Plan be amended to incorporate additional Texas Commission on Environmental Quality requirements as provided in Texas Administrative Code Title 30 §288 peliaining to Water Conservation and Drought Contingency Plans; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Groesbeck believes that it is in the best interest of the City of Groesbeck to amend its current water conservation and emergency water demand management plan.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROESBECK, TEXAS:

- **Section 1**: That the Year 2024 Amendment to the City of Groesbeck Water Conservation and Emergency Water Demand Management Plan attached hereto and made part hereof for all purposes be, and the same is hereby, adopted as the official policy of the City.
- **Section2**: That all ordinances of the City in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are, and the same are hereby, repealed and all other ordinances of the City not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
- **Section 3:** Should any paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause, phrase, or section of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provision thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid, illegal, or unconstitutional.
- **Section 4**: This ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption, as the law in such cases provide.
