#### **ORDINANCE 14-O-04**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GROESBECK, TEXAS, REGARDING THE REQUIREMENT OF **OCCUPANCY** PERMITS WHERE RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS HAVE CHANGED SERVICE, PROVIDING UTILITY FOR SEVERABILITY, PROVIDING A PENALTY AND DECLARING **AN EMERGENCY** 

# NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROESBECK, TEXAS, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Where water, gas or electrical service to a residential property is changed from one customer to another, the new customer, within ten days of the change in name on the utility account, shall have the property inspected and obtain a new certificate of occupancy.

Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance, or its application to any person or circumstance, be declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid for any reason, or should any portion of this Ordinance be pre-empted by State or

federal law or regulation, such decision or pre-emption shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance or its application to other persons or circumstances.

It is found that an emergency and urgent public necessity exist which requires the immediate passage of this ordinance.

Any person violating any provision of this Ordinance within the corporate limits of the City of Groesbeck, Texas shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be

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fined an amount not exceeding five hundred dollars (\$500.00). Each day that such violation continues shall be a separate offense.
